## Installation



**Important:** CARS-5 and later versions are not backwards-compatible with CARS 1.05 and older versions. **You will not be able to restore data from CARS 1.05 (or earlier) to CARS-5.** If you are updating to CARS-5 from CARS 1.05 (or earlier), generate and save all reports you wish to keep before installing CARS-5.

- **1.** If you have not done so, register for an account on the CARS website.
- **2.** Log in to your website account.
- 3. Go to the Download CARS page, select Access CARS for macOS, then select Download CARS for macOS.
- 4. Click on the CARS installation file.
- 5. Open the CARS Installer icon.
- **6.** If the following security window appears click **Open** and proceed to step 7. If there is no **Open** button, advance to step 6a/b.



- **6a.** If you get a message that reads "CARS installer.app" can't be opened..." select **OK.**
- **6b.** Open macOS **System Preferences**, then select **Security & Privacy**, then select **Open Anyway**. Return to step 6.

- **7.** The CARS Installer will begin preparing the installation. Once the installation is prepared, select **Next.**
- **8.** To install CARS in the /Applications folder by default, select **Next**. To save CARS to a different directory, select **Browse...**, then choose the location to install CARS and select **OK**.



- **9.** When the installer has completed, select **Finish**.
- **10.** Locate the CARS Installer icon on the desktop, then right click the icon and select **Eject "CARS"**.
- **11.** To open CARS, open the folder where it is stored and double-click the icon.
