CARS-5 Quick Guide

Important: The administrator cannot conduct assessments or be assigned modules. However, the administratoe account is necassary for selecting/changing modules for user accounts. You must sign into a different user account to administer a CARS session.

Important: The following steps must be completed on the **primary networked computer.**

1. Sign in with the administrator username and password.

2. Select the Administrator tab, then select Add/Modify User

3. From the list of current users, select the user that you would like to assign modules to (or remove modules from) and click **Modify User**.

4. Select Set/Change User's CARS Modules.
