**1.** Sign in with the administrator username and password.

## 2. Select the Administrator tab, then select Add/Modify User

**3.** If you are not already logged in as the administrator, enter the administrator user-name and password.

**4.** From the list of current users, select the user that you would like to assign modules to (or remove modules from) and click **Modify User**.
