CARS Website: carstrainingcenter.org

The CARS website is for you to provide your information, learn more about CARS and download the most recent version of CARS.

Username: your email address you used when you registered for the CARS website

Password: created by you when you registered for the CARS website

CARS Software

CARS is the software you downloaded to run CARS sessions.

ADMINISTRATOR

Username: admin

Note: the administrator account will always have the username admin. This username cannot be changed.

Password: carsadmin (First time login)

Note: The second time you log in CARS will prompt you to create a new password for the admin account.

USER ACCOUNTS

The username and password can be anything you want. You will create the user accounts under the Administrator tab → Add/Modify User→ Add User.

Enter the username and password you would like to use and then select add user. You can come back to this window at any time to turn on modules for this user.

Frequently Asked Questions:

Q: What if I did not get my website or CARS registration email?

A: Please check your spam folder as the emails sometimes get stuck in there. For the CARS website, if you do not see it in spam, please email support@carstrainingcenter.org. For CARS, if you do not see it in spam, try connecting your computer to a different network, such as a mobile hotspot, and resend the email by redoing site registration.

Q: What if I forgot my password?

A: CARS Website: On the bottom of the login page on the CARS website, click "Forgot your password?". This will prompt you to enter your email address linked to your account. You will then receive an email with a ink to reset your password.

A: CARS Installation:

Admin password: When you select any administrator function you will be prompted to login. Under the boxes for username and password, select "Forgot password" and then select "Admin password recovery".

CARS User Account password: You can view the username and password of all user accounts created on your CARS installation at any time by going to the administrator tab and selecting "Add/Modify User". This will bring up a table with the list of user accounts you have created. Select the user account you are looking for and click "Modify User".
